VENUE, DATES & TIMES

The training lasts for two hours and would normally be a twilight / early evening session, however, the timings can be negotiated. The training is held in your school.

FOCUS OF THE TRAINING

The training is aimed at governing bodies who wish to raise awareness of the current requirements of governors. It is made bespoke to your own school and the training is delivered in your own school by Jane Lodge (Associate Adviser), who is very experienced in supporting schools and their governing bodies.

OUTLINE OF THE TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT PACKAGE

- The training will enable governors to identify areas of strength and those that need addressing, and will give a clear picture of the current expectations for a governing body.
- Before the training takes place, data will be obtained relating to your school to enable the training to be completely bespoke to your needs.
- During the session the following areas will be focussed on:
 - Monitoring the School Improvement Plan
 - Understanding and challenging the school's progress data
 - Monitoring pupil premium
 - Staff appraisal
 - Statutory policies
