FOCUS OF THE TRAINING

Children are born mathematicians, recognising differences in amounts and shapes and looking for patterns in the world around them. They learn about mathematics by the doing of mathematics.

In this course we banish the worksheet and look at practical approaches, key vocabulary and learning questions to explore maths ideas and develop maths skills and concepts in the early years classroom. The activities will directly link with the early years outcomes / the early learning goals.

The training will look at the key elements of effective practice, this course is full of practical advice on how to plan an enabling environment; what the flow and balance of adult and child-initiated learning looks like and the importance of the Characteristics of Effective Learning. Delegates will also explore the key routines and practices which make early years so special.

- To explore ways to provide stimulating practical maths experiences for children in EYFS
- To develop the role of the practitioner in promoting the use of mathematical language
- To develop higher order thinking through maths based investigation and exploration
- To develop practitioner knowledge in assessing children' progress in maths.

OUTLINE OF THE TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT PACKAGE

- Opportunity to observe two taught sessions; 'Little Big Maths' and a focused maths session
- Opportunity to observe children learning through maths provision both indoor and outdoor.
Discussion around planning, equipment and differentiation with key staff. Including the use of 'Little Big Maths' and progression drivers to plan and set targets
- Opportunity to take ideas back to the delegates own setting.
